

“A Most Egg-cellent Adventure!”

Project Guidelines

At the end of the project, you are to turn in the following items:

- Your egg and its home. (They will be returned to you)
- Your diary entries
- Your daily time schedules
- A picture of your egg
- Your egg's birth certificate
- Your egg's biography

1. Give Your Egg an Identity

1. You must give your egg an identity. This is in part shown by what you provide for your egg. The egg must have:

- a birth certificate
- a portrait of your egg (drawn or real)
- a face (body, clothes, etc... are extra)
- a sturdy carrier or home
- toys, accessories and other items
- a biography

2. Take Care of That Egg

You must keep your egg safe. This means you cannot leave the egg in a locker, on a table where it could fall off, or in a car unattended. You cannot mistreat the egg by throwing it around or holding it in a careless manner! You cannot let other people mistreat your egg. You should not let other people care for it who are irresponsible. (You will be held accountable for letting an irresponsible person hurt your egg). If your original egg dies, you are to adopt another egg.

If you do not provide attention and quality care for your egg, you may be brought up on Neglect or Abuse charges and have to appear before a jury of your peers!!! You will take a parenthood pledge that can be used against you in a court of law.

3. Time Schedule Instructions

You should plan on keeping the egg with you at all times. This activity will serve no purpose if you do not care for the egg. You are to fill in a **Time Schedule** each day. Indicate **what** your egg was doing each hour and **who** was caring for it.

While you are expected to provide almost all the care for your egg, you can hire an egg-sitter, if necessary. If you are not in direct contact with the egg, you must have an egg-sitter. You are allowed only 8 hours of free egg-sitting time for the entire project. All egg-sitters must sign your form as an egg-sitter. If you do not have a signed egg-sitter, it will be assumed the egg was left unattended and you may be brought up on charges of neglect.

4. Diary Instructions

You must keep a diary of your egg's experiences. It will include:

- a) three activities or situations your egg was involved in
- b) a problem you encountered
- c) a reaction by a friend, or a family member
- d) a final reflection of the experience

The "activity" diaries are to be written from the egg's point of view. Write them as if the egg was writing. The other three entries are to be written by you. Remember, that the reason for this project is to provide, protect, nurture and care for something other than yourself.




